THE BEST PEACHES IN THE WEST

Manas Ranch grows apricots and six varieties of peaches, named “the Best Peaches in the West” by *Sunset Magazine*. Peaches are available from mid-June to mid-October but the flavor is available year-round with Manas’ homemade jams and toppings.

Manas Ranch also operates one of the few local USDA-approved meat packing facilities, offering a wide selection of cuts from local ranchers and farmers
